

# **Newsletter February 2013**

Thanks to all TB:HIV study investigators for your excellent work and continuous contribution to the TB:HIV study. Your efforts are much appreciated!

### **ENROLMENT STATUS**

As of 1st of February 2013, 940 patients have been enrolled in the TB:HIV Study. Enrolment status and enrolment targets per region are shown in Figure 1. The goal for the end of 2013, when the study recruitment period ends, is a minimum of 1400 persons. Please remember to send us enrolment forms for all eligible coinfected patients seen at your department.



# **FOLLOW-UP STATUS**

Of all patients diagnosed with TB in 2011, we are missing recent follow-up data for 32%, either because the patient hasn't been at the clinic for more than half a year or because we simply haven't received a completed follow-up form.

We strongly encourage all investigators to send us as complete follow-up data as possible. Information on patients who have missed clinical appointments or who haven't been seen at the clinic for longer periods may be found by contacting other clinics in the area, dispensaries, NGOs, accessing death registries etc.

In December 2012, we sent out a new batch of follow-up forms (6 and 12 months follow-up forms) and the deadline for returning these is 1 March
